9. (10 Min) Presentation, Discussion, and Possible Motion: A representative from the Valley Plaza Recreation Center to address the board regarding scheduled events to be held at the center in 2016 (dates and times, budget for each event, and anticipated request for funding/participation from the NoHoWest NC).
10. (10 Min) Discussion and Possible Motion: The board will vote to support the following statement: As presented by Glenn Bailey (Executive Board Member (VANC), Treasurer (LANC), Van Nuys NC board member) at November 16th General Board meeting, "we the North Hollywood West (Neighborhood Council) formally agree to be a member of the Neighborhood Council Sustainability Alliance. The Neighborhood Council Sustainability Alliance advances sustainability and resilience across Los Angeles through advocacy, sharing of best practices and community action." Neighborhood Councils deal with a variety of issues. Many of those issues that impact our communities are directly tied to sustainability: transportation, pollution, quality of life, public health, urban forestry, park equity, water quality, water supply, energy and more. Working together gives us a stronger voice in pursuing solutions that will serve us all.
11. (10 Min) Discussion and Possible Motion: In the event agenda item number nine (9) is approved, the board will then vote to appoint a representative(s) to the sustainability alliance (each member of the NC will have a vote). If two or more representatives of a NC decide to join the NCSA and are present when a vote is taken, the representatives will need to decide amongst themselves how to cast that vote. (This is the same procedure utilized by VANC and LANCC)." after "(each member of the NC will have a vote).

(10 Min) Presentation, Discussion and Possible Motion: Nicholas and Hortencia Goodman of the International Film Festival North Hollywood to address the board and give a report and analysis of this past Summer's film screening of "Babe" in our district at Jamie Beth Von Slavin park and of the series as a whole. Asking for up to \$3,000 to pay for the "Free Summer Movie Series." It is as of yet undetermined if any or how many screenings will take place in our district next Summer. The sponsorship goes towards production expenses including equipment, printing, publicity, promotion and legal fees. Itemized expense sheets to be distributed.
13. (5 Min) Discussion & Action: Appoint a point person to interface with Wendy Moore on NoHo West NC website matters. Only that person will deal with Moore on website issues.
14. (5 Min) Discussion and Possible Action: Modify previous board vote count to make the annual expenditure on website maintenance \$5,000 per year retroactive to July 1, 2016.
