Re: Planting/Irrigation Plan for Slope north of Railroad Tracks
Date: October 21, 2021

Woods Maintenance Services, Inc. proposes the following work to take place on the Whitsett Slope, north of the railroad tracks. For the purposes of this proposal, the “north side” shall refer to the landscaped area north of the mural, and the “south side” shall refer to the area south of the mural, directly north of the railroad tracks.

Job #1:

- Plant approximately 25 plants on the south side to fill in gaps that have remained since we first began this project a few years ago. Due to the irrigation problems arising from homeless vandalism and the nature of the soil in general, the south slope has proven to be a difficult place for plants to thrive. By planting approximately ½ the number of plants needed, all parties will be able to evaluate how well the vegetation grows in this difficult environment. Based on the results, we can adjust the plan for the second ½ of the planting operation, if necessary.

Fee for Job #1: \$2,475.00

Job #2:

- Inspect irrigation on the north side, make fixes and adjustments as necessary, and plant approximately 30 plants as fill-in to gaps that have emerged on this side of the slope.

Fee for Job # 2: \$1,425.00

Job #3:

- Make a crew available for assisting with the spreading of mulch during a community-based event on a date to be determined in 2022.

Fee for Job # 3: \$475.00

Total fee for all work proposed: \$4,375.00
