The hard number of increased crime is 12 for the year, which is about 6%. There has been a decrease in the homelessness in Valley Village. Call 911 for burglaries in progress.
	 b. <u>LAPD Captain Email: 32151@lapd.online</u> Call 911 for emergencies. Don't call the front desk, which is only for reports after the fact or non-emergencies. Call 311 for resources. Arrest numbers are up. Each month a community newsletter is put out which includes crime tips. North Hollywood Police Station has a personnel shortage due to officer injuries and vacations.
